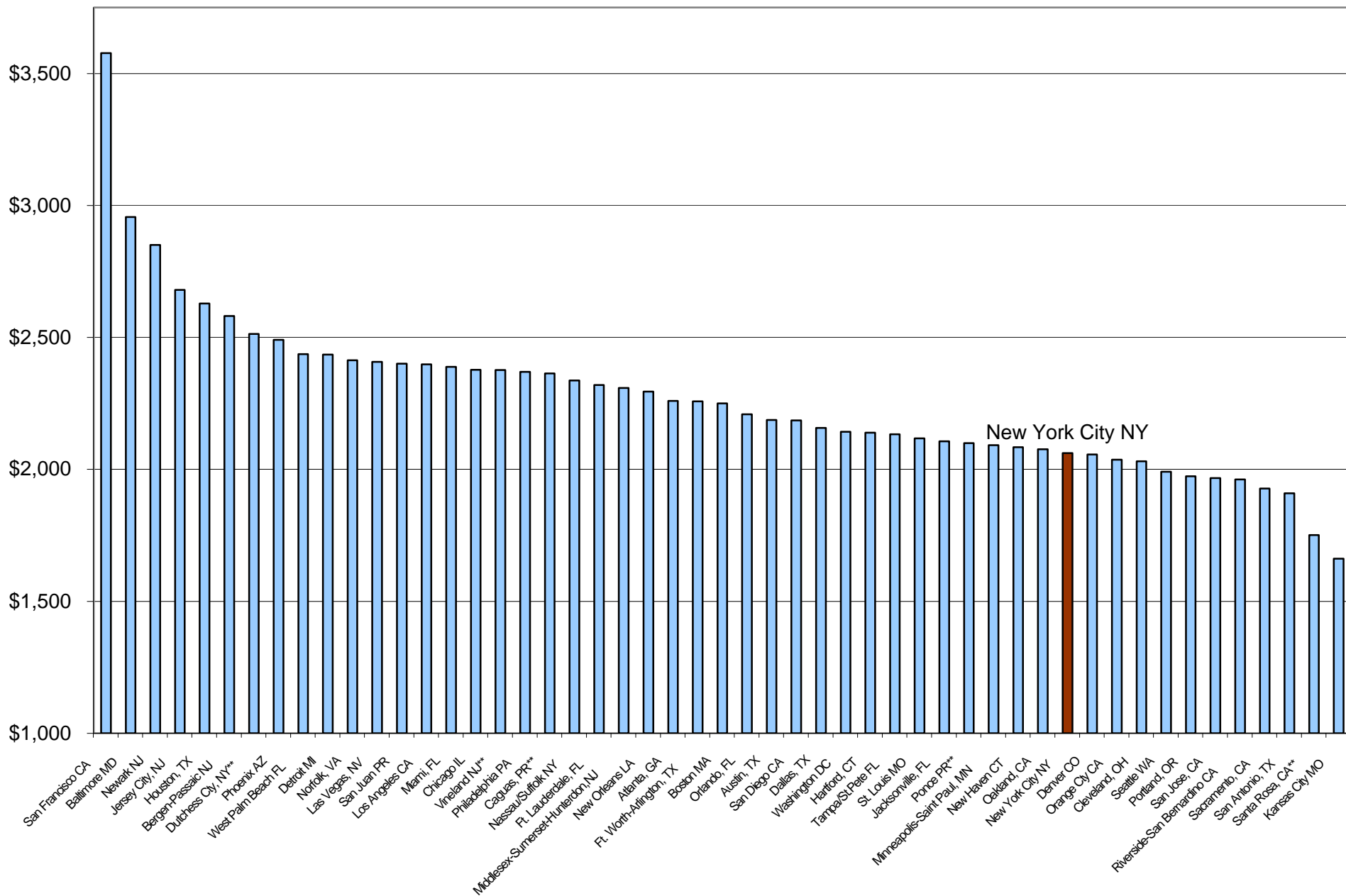
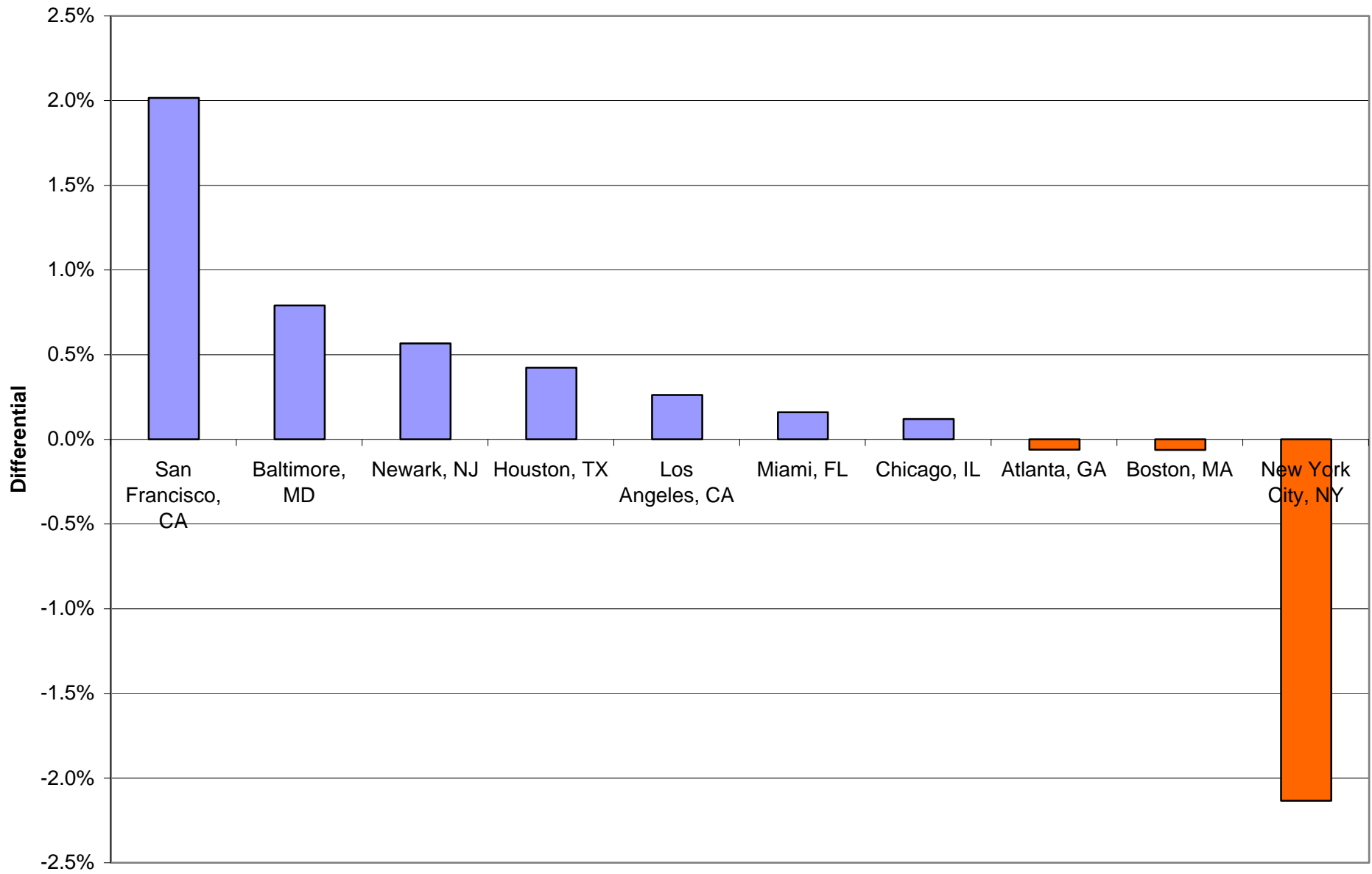


Title I Award Per Living AIDS Case: New York, 12th from the Bottom
